Semester Abroad

- Students earn Penn credit while abroad for a semester or year through one of over 100 partner institutions
- Through a variety of options, students have the ability to enhance language skills or study in English while increasing cultural competence in an immersive, academic environment
- Students are billed Penn tuition and the study abroad fee (replacing the general fee) and are able to use financial aid and scholarships, just as they would at Penn



Global Research & Internship Program

- Students intern or conduct research abroad for 8 to 12 weeks over the summer
- Over 200 pre-approved placements are available around the world in a wide variety of career industries
- Every accepted student receives a funding award to offset expenses, including flights, housing, or meals
- In collaboration with SFRS, rising juniors or seniors that are Highly Aided receive a GRIP funding award for 100% of the total estimated cost



Penn Global Seminars

- Courses offer intensive semester-long study with a short-term travel component aimed at deepening understanding of concepts discussed in the classroom
- Each PGS course is worth 1 C.U.
- The flat program fee of \$950 covers all travel expenses, including round-trip airfare
- Financial aid packages may be applied to offset the cost of the program fee
